RE: Cuba Lake District Garbage Pickup for the year 2009

Collections are to be made weekly, each Monday of the week starting May 4, 2009 through October 26, 2009, for all household garbage that is left for pickup within the Cuba Lake District. As a definite time for pickup cannot be given, it is strongly recommended that you place your garbage at the roadside by 7:00 a.m.

The Cuba Lake District Board of Commissioners has passed a regulation requiring that any garbage or refuse placed along the side of the road be placed in a hard container with a cover, as in the case of a typical garbage can. Leaving garbage in plastic garbage bags along the roadside often results in dogs, other animals or the wind spreading the garbage all over.

LARGE REFUSE TYPE MATERIALS WILL BE COLLECTED TWICE DURING THIS CONTRACT PERIOD. THE DATES FOR THESE LARGE REFUSE TYPE MATERIALS COLLECTIONS ARE THE FIRST MONDAY IN JUNE 2009 AND THE LAST MONDAY IN AUGUST 2009. NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO RECYCLING ON THE DATES OF LARGE REFUSE PICKUP.

All garbage and refuse for collection must be placed at the roadside. Pickup will be made along county roads or access lanes used for multiple residents where possible. Covers will be replaced on garbage cans after collection and reasonable care will be taken to not damage cans or make an excessive amount of noise during collection.

Recyclables (sorted as per enclosed notice) will also be picked up weekly during the term of this contract.

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR RECYCLING

The following materials are recyclable and are accepted by SDS, when prepared in the following manner:

- GLASS BOTTLES:** Rinsed and dry. Metal and plastic caps/rings must be removed.
- GLASS JARS:** Rinsed and dry. Lids must be removed. May be mixed with glass bottles.
- ALUMINUM CANS:** Beverage cans (beer and pop). Rinsed and dry.
- TIN CANS:** Rinsed and dry. NO rusty cans will be accepted. Metal lids must be disposed of with regular garbage unless secured in can and flattened.
- PLASTIC BOTTLES:** Includes: milk jugs, pop bottles, bleach and liquid soap bottles (laundry). Each must be rinsed and dry and caps removed. NO oil or anti-freeze bottles accepted.
- NEWSPAPERS:** Must be clean, dry and tied in bundles. NO shiny pages or magazines will be accepted.
- CARDBOARD:** Only corrugated types. Must be clean, dry and broken down in bundles. May be used as recycling container for other recyclables listed above.
